On the 29th of July, the students of Class XII Science were taken to the Vidya Academy of Science & Technology. They set off from school at 8:45 am. and reached the college campus by 9:30 am. Mr. Shankar welcomed them on behalf of the entire college faculty and gave them a brief introduction on the Association of Skill Centre with IEDC (Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Centre) to develop Robots.

Next they had a training session on IOTs and Robotics which was led by Mr. Sachin Sudheesh, who is a triple EEE graduate, Robotics trainer and RPA specialist. He was also assisted by Jeeva, a final year student.

The students were first introduced to the basics of Robotics, functioning of robots and their different types. MAY HER SOUL REST IN PEACE

On Monday, the 25th of June, a team of five doctors from Atreya Hospital, Thrissur, in collaboration with the American Heart Association (AHA), launched an initiative called 'Heart safe Thrissur initiative - Family and Friends CPR initiative', at Hari Sri Vidya Nidhi School, Punkunnam. The team was led by Dr. Ramkumar Menon, the Medical Director of Atreya Hospital and Prof. Dr. Sachin V. Menon, the Regional Director of the American Heart Association. Dr. Varghese, Dr. Linis Liz and Dr. Pranav Kumar, also from Atreya Hospital, Thrissur, were part of the team. The initiative is their very first venture in educating school students on how to perform Coronary Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) on both adults and infants. The initiative was launched and the programme inaugurated at Hari Sri Vidya Nidhi School by the performing of CPR on an adult and infant dummy by the Principal, Mrs Preetha Venugopal, and the Executive Director, Mrs Deepti Menon respectively. The students of class XI and XII were imparted hands-on training on CPR for both adults as well as infants, and the team of doctors spread awareness on the required procedures and some related first aid.

Health check-up Conducted
